

Slavic 108Y Elementary Ukrainian Prepositions and the Cases they Govern

These prepositions take Genitive Case only:

This preposition governs Genitive when it indicates direction and Instrumental when it indicates accompaniment:

These prepositions govern Accusative, when they indicate direction and Instrumental, when they indicate location:

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| між | between |
| за | behind, beyond: + <u>Acc.</u> , for |
| над | above, over |
| перед | in front of |
| під | under |

These prepositions govern Accusative, when they indicate direction, and Locative, when they indicate location:

| на | onto; on |
| у (в) | in |
| по | + <u>Acc.</u> , for, on; + <u>Loc.</u> , along |
| о, (об) | + <u>Acc.</u> , about, against; + <u>Loc.</u> , at (time) |
| у (в) + <u>Gen.</u> | at, in (someone's place, or possession) |
